Addiction is the term given to a pattern of behavior that causes negative consequences for the individual. Most people assume that addiction refers only to those who have a compulsive need for a particular substance such as alcohol or drugs. However, in reality, it is possible to become addicted to almost anything. To be clear, this condition occurs when a person continues to do something despite knowing that it will have an adverse impact on his or her life. Because of the various causes and triggers, there are many different types of addictions. According to the Magnitude of Substance Use in India report submitted by the National Drug Dependence Treatment Centre of the All-India Institute of Medical Sciences to the Ministry in February this year, 1.3% of children between 10 and 17 years reported current use of alcohol, 0.9% reported use of cannabis, 1.8% reported use of opioid and 1.17% reported use of inhalants. According to the 2017 report by United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), 255 million people worldwide use illicit drugs, of which 29.5 million suffered from drug use-related disorders. So, it is necessary to spread awareness about addiction and its drawbacks over the young generation. In this context, NSS volunteer had taken a lead and extended the helping hand to manage and support De-addiction workshop. The workshop Schedule is given in following table,
